- **Hunting, Fishing, & Camping** – Abundance of hunting opportunities include deer, pheasant, ducks, and geese; fishing at the Tioga Dam; and ice-fishing 30 miles away on beautiful Lake Sakakawea.
- **Tioga Golf Course** – Challenging nine-hole grass-greens course, located one mile northwest of Tioga.
- **Tioga Parks** – Cool off in the summer at the swimming pool and City Park. Park your RV and enjoy the day near the sheltered picnic area and have a nice cook out. This park is located on 4th St. NE in Tioga. You will also find a frisbee golf course, softball diamond, tennis courts and jungle gym! In the winter enjoy ice skating in the park!
