### Tioga Medical Center Introduces New Lung Cancer Screening

Tioga Medical Center is pleased to offer low-dose lung cancer screening to the community – an important step in detecting lung cancer earlier, when it is most treatable. This screening uses a low-dose version of the familiar CT scan and is proven to be both safe and effective for individuals at high risk for developing lung cancer. “Like all cancers, early detection is critical in determining treatment success,” says Jeff Moberg, PA, a provider at Tioga Medical Center. “The low-dose CT screening allows us to detect lung cancer before symptoms even appear, giving patients a better chance at successful treatment.” To qualify for the screening, patients must meet all the following criteria: Be 50-80 years of age. Have a 20 pack-year history of smoking (for example, one pack per day for 20 years, two packs per day for 10 years, etc.) Currently smoke, or have quit within the past 15 years. Kresta Hauge, Director of Radiology at Tioga Medical Center, emphasizes the simplicity of the exam: “A low-dose lung CT scan uses advanced imaging technology to capture detailed pictures of your lungs while exposing you to significantly less radiation than a standard CT scan. It’s quick, painless, and non-invasive.” According to the American Lung Association, lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths in the United States, yet only 16% of individuals at high risk have been screened. Expanding access to low-dose CT screening is one way Tioga Medical Center is working to change that—helping patients take a proactive step toward protecting their health. **Superintendent's Scoop – Spring of 2026 - Paul Olson.**  
 Our current weather may be telling us it is still winter, but as for school events we are in full spring mode of operation. Our spring sports (softball, baseball, track, and boys' golf) have begun practices and preparing for competition. Our track participants already had their first meet in Williston. We will not be holding any track meets this year, but it is something we are hoping to do in the future. We still need to have the final surface on the track laid. Last fall the weather turned cold too soon for the final layer to stick. Therefore, this work will now take place in June. In addition, our students in our Robotics/Lego League, Tech Team, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, and Drama Club have also been busy competing. We also had students competing in the State Science Fair. Central Elementary School will be hosting their spring music concerts in the Old Gym at the high school. Grades 1-3 will be at 5:30pm and grades 4-5 at 6:30pm on Thursday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. The music concert for our Kindergarten students will be held at Central Elementary School on Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm. For the high school, their scheduled music concert has run into some conflicts with other events resulting in a date yet to be determined. The high school has set a date for Prom, and it will be held Saturday, April 18<sup>th</sup>. Each spring our students complete a summative state assessment – ND A+. This state required test assesses what the students have learned throughout the school year. Students in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10 complete the ND A+ in Reading, Writing and Math. Students in grades 4, 8, and 10 also complete an assessment in science. For Central Elementary School, students will complete the assessments beginning Tuesday, April 14<sup>th</sup> through Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>. At the high school, students will complete the assessments from Monday, April 13<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. Our teachers have worked hard all year in helping students learn as much as possible, and it is our hope that they will give their best effort on the assessments. Therefore, we ask that you impress upon your child(ren) to take the assessment seriously. As educators in the Tioga Public School District #15, it is our goal for each child to acquire a passing score on all sections of the state assessment. This year North Dakota's Department of Public Instruction is providing a website where you will be able to access your child's assessment results through the Family Portal when results of the ND A+ assessment are released in late June. The platform will provide on-screen score information with resources to help interpret results, a personalized video report explaining your child's performance, and the ability to download the full Individual Student Report (ISR). The site's address is as follows: ndaplus.mypearsonsupport.com (Home | ND A+ Portal). Also with each spring, our seniors begin to mentally make that transition into life after school. As a long-time educator, I've witnessed firsthand the worries, doubts, and excitement during this time. As a result, I personally wish our graduates the very best during these last two months of school and into next year as they begin their next journey. The high school graduation ceremony will take place on Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 2:30pm at Tioga High School. I encourage you to attend and wish our graduates the very best.
