
Nation. NESET is more than the signs and names and the trucks driving these roads. We are men and women – the



Bakken Update with Kathleen Neset



As we come into the summer months on these beautiful northern plains, we realize that under that cover of snow of the past winter, our oil and gas industry continued to drill, complete, and produce oil and gas. We currently have about 34 rigs drilling along with ongoing completions and fracs and the always needed workover services. This oilfield is busy.

However, with the price of West Texas Intermediate Crude at about \$62.17 per barrel, some oil operators have begun slowing down operations. Prior to this, oil was staying somewhat steady at \$70.00 per barrel or slightly

more. Oil companies are structured different ways both operationally and financially. Each company will react to the oil and gas markets and the geo-political winds as best suits their individual situation. Yet, a drop in oil prices does have some operators pulling back some services, some wells are being drilled but not completed right away, and some well improvement strategies have been put on hold.

None of this is unusual for our industry. There is a constant and growing need for energy in this country and around the world. Although we may see some short-term reduction in the number of rigs and services, I expect to see an overall continued presence and business continuity. If the price of oil drops significantly – it will impact our day-to-day operations.

Another impact on our lives is the continued business strategy of mergers and acquisitions in the oil and gas industry. We have seen several changes in this way, and I expect to see this trend continue. Sometimes this brings changes right to us individually with jobs impacted and sometimes it is just a name change – to us in the field. Regardless, it is a part of doing business and we should be aware of these changes.

Each of us is a part of a crucial industry to the safety and security and of this great nation and I look forward to our continued importance of the Bakken and North Dakota oil and gas.
