





Kindergarteners and all students required to be up-to-date on immunizations

Section 23-07-17.1 section of North Dakota State Law entitled Inoculation Required before Admission to School mandates that all students through grade 12 meet a minimum number of required immunizations prior to school entrance. These requirements can be waived only for medical, philosophical, moral or religious

Reminder: Students entering the 7th grade must have their Tdap and Meningococcal vaccinations. Students entering 11th and 12th grades are now required to have 2 Meningococcal vaccinations. Immunization requirements are posted on the school's website in the Forms folder under Documents and on the health department website: http://bit.ly/NDVaccination
